thank you, Lord Russell

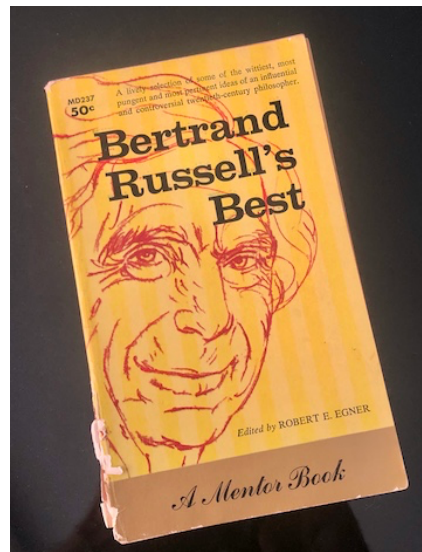
